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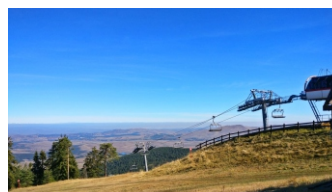
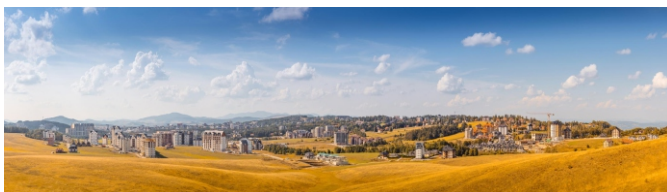


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VENUE



Venue Location: The 3x3 basketball courts will be located at Kraljevski Square, the central hub of Zlatibor. Two courts will be set up in the heart of the main promenade, surrounded by hotels, restaurants, and tourist facilities. Major hotels such as Mona and Palisad, as well as the TRK Sports Hall, are all within 20–100 meters walking distance. This unique setup provides perfect conditions for players, officials, and fans, with everything conveniently accessible on foot in one of the most popular tourist destinations in the region.



Weather conditions: Early September in Zlatibor offers ideal conditions for outdoor sports. Daytime temperatures range between 19°C and 25°C, with cooler evenings around 9–14°C. The weather is mostly sunny with light winds and minimal rainfall, making it perfect for hosting international 3x3 basketball competitions.

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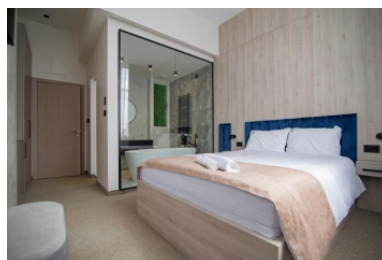


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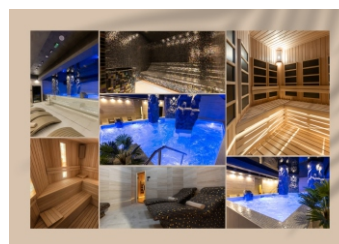

The official international airport for the arrival of delegations is Nikola Tesla Belgrade (BEG). The organizers provided organized transportation for all participants and delegation members from the airport to the hotel on Zlatibor.

Organized buses will take them directly from Belgrade to the hotel on Zlatibor.

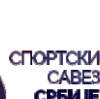
All details about flights and transfers are coordinated by SSGS in cooperation with local organizations

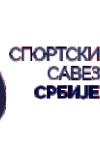

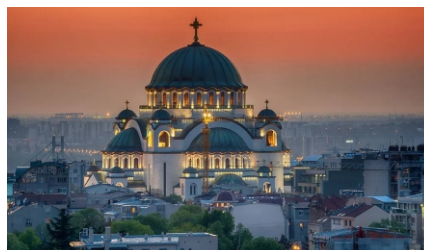

Zlatibor is a picturesque mountain region in western Serbia, known for its natural beauty, mild climate, and vibrant tourism scene. A popular destination for relaxation, health tourism, and outdoor activities, Zlatibor features lush forests, scenic meadows, and diverse hiking trails. Its high-quality hotels and resorts offer comfortable accommodations, with many located close to sports facilities, making it ideal for athletes and enthusiasts alike.

Beyond its high-quality hotels and vibrant town center, Zlatibor offers unique attractions for visitors. Some of the top sights include Stopića Cave, with its impressive limestone formations and underground waterfalls; Gostilje Waterfall, one of the tallest in Serbia and surrounded by lush greenery; and Tornik Ski Center, a top spot for winter sports enthusiasts, offering skiing, snowboarding, and panoramic views of the area. Zlatibor also features the Dino Park, a family-friendly attraction with life-size dinosaur models and various activities, and Mokra Gora, home to the Šargan Eight railway, a scenic narrow-gauge train ride through mountainous terrain.

Did you know ?



Zlatibor is home to the Gold Gondola, which is currently the longest panoramic gondola lift in the world! Stretching over 9 kilometers (about 5.6 miles), it connects the center of Zlatibor with the top of Tornik Mountain. The scenic 25-minute ride provides breathtaking views of Zlatibor's landscapes, passing over rolling hills, lush forests, and Ribničko Lake.

Zlatibor in English translation means Golden Tree



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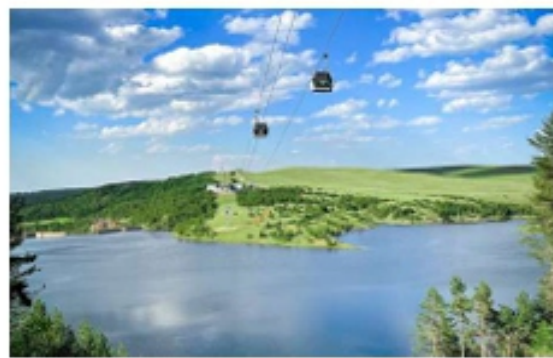

► TOURS AND ATTRACTIONS

GOLD GONDOLA is the longest tourist cable ride at the world with it's length of 9 kilometres. During the ride guests enjoy in stunning view of rolling mountain slopes covered with golden pine trees, after which the mountain was named.



STOPIĆA CAVE is the most visited cave in Serbia. Due to it's unique natural characteristics, length of almost 1,7 kilometres Stopica Cave was declared a natural monument by a 2005 decree of the Government of Republic Serbia.

► TOURS AND ATTRACTIONS

GOSTILJE WATERFALL is one of the most attractive hydrological features of Zlatibor. The water cascades down from 22- meter- high limestone cliff, forming a unique waterfall. The area around is fully developed for tourist visits, with walking trails, football field, swimming pool and children's playground.

ADVENTURE PARK and DINO PARK The largest in the Balkans, the adventure park extends over an area of 4 ha where is a lot of content for children, but also for adults: adventure park, zip line, artificial rock climbing, children's dino village, 6D cinema, polygon for roller skating and quads for children. Within the park there is a restaurant where, along with excellent coffee and freshly squeezed juices, traditional specialties of the Zlatibor region are served.

MUSEUM "OLD VILLAGE" SIROGOJNO 26 km away from the tourist centre Zlatibor, in the village Sirogojno, there is the only open air museum in Serbia "Staro Selo". Works on construction of this museum started in 1979. On a 5 hectare location beside St. Peter and Paul's church, old log houses were brought from all parts of Zlatibor to be presented and preserved here.
